

"Easy-Set" Mole Eliminator

You have purchased the most effective and most humane mole control device available. A burrowing mole will create an unsightly and dangerous ridge in a manicured lawn at a rate of up to 60 feet in an hour. This amazing patented invention eliminates pesky moles from your lawn or garden, not just driving them out to relocate and cause damage elsewhere. The "EASY-SET" mole eliminator is safe for use around children and pets, and is not hazardous to the environment.

Operating Instructions

HOW AND WHERE.

Setting your Mole Eliminator properly is very important for effective operation. Locate an active mole run (tunnel). An active tunnel will have fresh, moist, worked-up soil.

Using a pencil or small stick, poke it into the mole tunnel several times to determine the approximate width and depth. The greater the width usually indicates that the tunnel has been in use for a longer period and more often. A 4-1/2 inch depth or less tunnel is an ideal location to set the trap.

SETTING THE MOLE ELIMINATOR.

Step (1)..... Press the center of the mole tunnel down with the heel of your foot until the ground feels solid. (You are actually closing the tunnel). Push the closed jaws of the trap straight down with a rocking motion into the mole run, with the trigger centered over the flattened area. The frame should be even with the flattened ground surface. Both jaws should be centered over



and in line with the run. **Note: the trap will not catch anything if positioned improperly. Both jaws must open across the tunnel.**

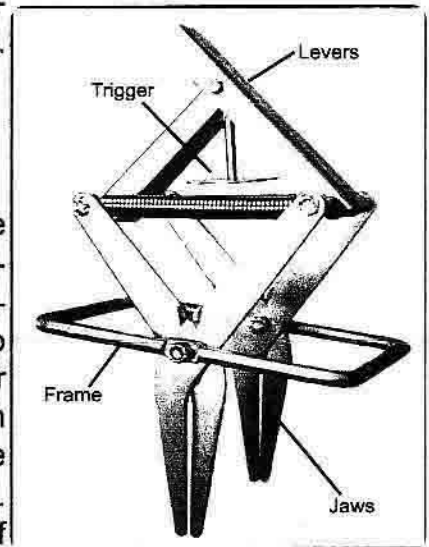
WARNING: Do not step on the levers before the jaws are positioned in the ground.

Step (2).... Step straight down on the lever of the trap as shown in the photograph. In hard or rocky soil a repeated stepping motion may

be necessary to open the jaws fully and set the trap. The trigger should now be centered over the tunnel and in contact with the flattened surface. Your Mole Eliminator is now ready to "Snap" into action with the return of a pesky mole.

REMOVING AND RELOCATING TRAP.

Releasing the Mole Eliminator (un-setting) is accomplished by lifting up under the top lever (near the hole) with a small stick until the trap is fully released. Pull the trap out of the ground. If relocating to another area, repeat the setting instructions.



REMOVING MOLE FROM TRAP.

When the levers of the trap pop up, it indicates that a mole has been caught. To remove the dead mole from the trap, pull the trap out of the ground with a rocking motion. Grab the frame and pull the levers against your body to open the jaws slightly, just enough to allow the mole to drop out.

CAUTION! DO NOT OPEN JAWS ALL THE WAY AS THIS MAY CAUSE INJURY.

Caring for your Mole Eliminator. Do not use grease or oil as a lubricant....use silicone spray and only if necessary. Moles can smell artificial odors, even food grade oil, and will avoid the trap or dig a new tunnel around it. Do not touch the jaws of the trap, but if you do, just insert the closed jaws in and out of soft ground several times to remove the human scent. Gloves are recommended when handling.
